One of the most memorable parts of childhood for many people is the sense of freedom and achievement that came from playing with friends in a playground and climbing higher, sliding faster or swinging higher than you thought possible. Unfortunately this simple joy is denied to some children because the standard design of playgrounds makes them inaccessible.

Boundless Canberra is the name given to **The Centenary of Canberra National Children's Playground** – a project to build the first all abilities playground in the ACT.

Located on the foreshore of Lake Burley Griffin, this AFL field size playground will be the first space in the ACT where children, young people and adults, including those with disabilities, can play with their friends and family.

Importantly, the equipment is easily accessible by children of all ability levels without being readily identifiable as 'disabled access' equipment.

Playing is important for all children, not only so they can have fun, but also to aid learning and development. Boundless will help children improve their coordination, muscle strength, language, cognitive thinking and reasoning abilities.

The first stage of the Boundless playground will be opened this year. The opening of this first stage will enable people to see the innovation in design and workmanship that will ensure Boundless is Australia's premier playground.

Building a playground of the size and significance of Boundless requires support from the

community. To date, individuals, the public service and private sector have generously gotten behind this project, but funds are still being raised to complete the playground.

Donations to Boundless Canberra are tax deductible. This is a rare chance to help create a space that will improve the lives of others and give all children the chance to just be a kid for a little while – to play, laugh and have fun.

Once it is finished, Boundless Canberra will be a tangible demonstration of our commitment to ensuring all children, regardless of ability, are given every opportunity to thrive, grow and enjoy life.

## Direct Debit Request Service Agreement Terms and Conditions

### Our Responsibility:

- We will process the Direct Debit Request within 5 business days and may process the Direct Debit as soon as 1 business day following the date you signed the Direct Debit Request.
- You may also contact the Direct Debit Request by contacting us on 13 25 85 (between 8:00am – 8:00pm Australian Central Time) the Financial Institution prior to the Direct Debit being processed.
- We will send you a Tax Receipt for any Donation Amount of \$2.00 or more to the email or postal address you have nominated in the Direct Debit Request within 10 business days following the date the Direct Debit is processed.

### Your Responsibility:

To ensure that there are no issues associated with the processing of this Direct Debit Request to facilitate your donation, we ask that you:

- confirm with your Financial Institution that direct debiting is available on your Nominated Account.
- check the Nominated Account details you have provided on the Direct Debit Request to ensure they are accurate. You should confirm these details with your Financial Institution if you are uncertain.
- confirm the details of the email or postal address you have provided on the Direct Debit Request for receiving your Tax Receipt are correct.
- ensure that the Nominated Account has sufficient funds to meet the Direct Debit amount for at least 5 business days following the date you signed the Direct Debit Request.
- Failure to do so may result in you being charged a fee by your Financial Institution.
