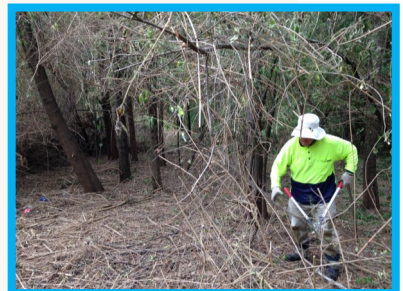
**Where:** Prospect Creek

Our work will focus on maintenance of previously planted native vegetation, weed removal, planting of native plants and flora and fauna surveying to improve the health of this invaluable wildlife corridor and .*
